

#### Historic Peace Agreement with UNLF

- Union Home Minister Amit Shah announced on Wednesday that the Union and Manipur governments have successfully signed a peace agreement with the United National Liberation Front (UNLF), marking a significant development in Manipur's history
- Note (30<sup>th</sup> December, 2023): ULFA faction signs peace agreement, Amit Shah hails it as a golden day for Assam
- It has also agreed to vacate all camps occupied by its armed cadres, engage in the peaceful democratic process established by law and maintain the integrity of the country

## What is the UNLF?

- Formed on November 24, 1964, the UNLF is the oldest valley-based insurgent group in Manipur
- Unlike groups in Naga-dominated and Kuki- Zomi dominated hills, the UNLF sought secession from India
- Led by Arembam Samarendra Singh, the group's central committee included leaders from Naga and Kuki communities. Trained by the NSCN (IM), the UNLF's armed wing, Manipur People's Army, was established in 1990

#### WHO's Agenda at COP28: Putting Health at the Center Stage

- In a historic move, health takes center stage at the 27-year-old United Nations Conference of Parties (COP) with a dedicated day on Health/Relief, Recovery, and Peace on December 3 in Dubai, the venue of COP28
- The day, hosted by the COP28 Presidency and the World Health Organization (WHO), features the first-ever climate-health ministerial, bringing together over 50 ministers from health, environment, and other sectors

#### NASA's Vision for Lunar Colonies by 2040

- NASA's ambitious plan to establish human settlements on the moon by 2040 has captivated the imagination of scientists, engineers, and dreamers worldwide
- The Artemis program, a comprehensive initiative by the US space agency, charts a course for humanity's significant leap beyond Earth, envisioning sustainable habitats on the lunar surface

#### Recovery and Reconstruction Plan Approved for Joshimath

- The Centre, led by a high-level committee headed by Union Home Minister Amit Shah, has approved a recovery and reconstruction plan for Joshimath in Uttarakhand
- This decision comes in response to the landslide and ground subsidence that affected the region earlier this year
- The approved plan allocates Rs 1658.17 crore for the recovery and reconstruction efforts

#### **First Woman Director General of ICFRE**

- In a significant milestone, Kanchan Devi, a 1991-batch Indian Forest Service Officer from the Madhya Pradesh cadre, has been appointed as the Director General (DG) of the Indian Council of Forestry Research and Education
- This marks a historic moment as Kanchan becomes the first woman officer to hold this prestigious position in the premier council under the Union Ministry of Environment, Forest, and Climate Change

#### **First Woman Director General of ICFRE**

 Indian Council of Forestry Research and Education (ICFRE), an apex body in the national forestry research system, has been undertaking the holistic development of forestry research through need based planning, promoting, conducting and coordinating research, education and extension covering all aspects of forestry

#### India Re-elected to International Maritime Organisation Council

- In a recent assembly, India achieved a significant milestone by being re-elected to the International Maritime Organisation (IMO) Council for the 2024–25 biennium
- This re-election places India in the esteemed Category of 10 states with the *"largest interest in international seaborne trade," standing alongside influential nations such as Australia, Brazil, Canada, France, Germany, the Netherlands, Spain, Sweden, and the United Arab Emirates (UAE)*

#### Indian Navy's New Survey Vessel Sandhayak

- Sandhayak, Yard 3025, the inaugural vessel among the four Survey Vessel (Large) ships, has been successfully delivered to the Indian Navy on December 4, 2023
- The SVL ships are designed by M/s Garden Reach Shipbuilders & Engineers (GRSE), Kolkata
- The primary role of the ship would be full scale coastal and deep-water Hydrographic Survey of Port/ Harbour approaches and determination of navigational channels/ routes
- Zone of operation includes maritime limits upto EEZ/ extended continental shelf

### Unprecedented Monkeypox Outbreak in the DRC

- The Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) is grappling with a severe monkeypox outbreak, with the World Health Organization (WHO) reporting a staggering 12,569 suspected cases and 581 deaths from January 1 to November 12, 2023
- This marks the highest annual case count ever recorded and poses significant challenges for the affected regions

# Monkeypox?

Mpox (formerly known as monkeypox) is a rare disease caused by infection with the mpox virus

 Monkeypox virus is part of the same family of viruses as variola virus, the virus that causes smallpox. Mpox symptoms are similar to smallpox symptoms, but milder, and mpox is rarely fatal.

#### **COP28** Declaration on Climate and Health

- Recently, the 28<sup>th</sup> Conference of Parties (COP28) to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) was held in Dubai, United Arab Emirates
- COP28, member countries reached an agreement to operationalize the Loss and Damage (L&D) fund aimed at compensating countries grappling with climate change impacts

#### **COP28** Declaration on Climate and Health

- The 28<sup>th</sup> UN Climate Change Conference (COP28) witnessed a significant development as 123 countries, including the United States, the United Kingdom, Germany, Australia, and the European Union, signed the Declaration on Climate and Health on December 2
- Notably, India has not yet signed, but commitments from additional countries are expected before COP28 concludes

#### Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Honored on Navy Day

- On Navy Day, December 4, Prime Minister Narendra Modi paid tribute to Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj and unveiled a grand statue of the 17<sup>th</sup>-century Maratha king at Sindhugarh, Maharashtra's coastal fort
- The Prime Minister acknowledged Shivaji's understanding of naval power and announced that naval officers' epaulettes would soon carry his emblem

# India and Kenya Sign 5 Pacts

- The discussions between Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Kenyan President William Samoei Ruto resulted in the signing of five pacts, fostering cooperation in diverse fields such as sports, education, and digital solutions
- Both leaders unveiled a joint vision document to enhance maritime engagement in the Indian Ocean region

#### **Strategic Focus on Duqm Port?**

- The Port of Duqm is strategically located situated on south eastern seaboard of Oman, overlooking Arabian Sea and Indian Ocean
- It is straddled along critical sea lanes in Arabian Sea and Gulf of Aden

#### **Strategic Focus on Duqm Port?**

- It is located in close proximity to Chabahar port in Iran (being developed by India to open a trade route to Afghanistan and Central Asia, bypassing Pakistan) and Gwadar Port in Pakistan which is developed by China as part of CPEC (China–Pakistan Economic Corridor)
- The port also has special economic zone, where about \$1.8 billion investments are being made by some Indian companies

#### Miyawaki Method Adopted for Forest Plantation in Chhattisgarh's Coal Belt

- In a move to enhance forest cover in Chhattisgarh's coal belt region, South Eastern Coalfields Ltd (SECL), a subsidiary of Coal India Ltd, is set to implement the Miyawaki method for the first time in its operational areas
- The Gevra Area of SECL will witness a two-hectare Miyawaki forest pilot project in collaboration with Chhattisgarh Rajya Van Vikas Nigam (CGRVVN) at an estimated cost of Rs 4 crores

# Miyawaki Method

- Japanese botanist Akira Miyawaki endowed the Miyawaki technique to create dense forests with native plants
- This unique method is used worldwide for urban afforestation by growing a forest in someone's backyard.

# Miyawaki Method

- The Miyawaki Method is one of the most effective tree planting methods for creating forest cover quickly on degraded land that has been used for other purposes such as agriculture or construction
- It is effective because it is based on natural reforestation principles, i.e. using trees native to the area and replicating natural forest regeneration processes
- It has some significant benefits over more traditional forestry methods when used in smaller afforestation projects and is particularly effective in the urban environment


## IUCN Red List Report on Extinction Threat to Freshwater Fish

 The International Union for Conservation of Nature Red List of Threatened Species, also known as the IUCN Red List or Red Data Book, founded in 1964, is an inventory of the global conservation status and extinction risk of biological species.

Extinct (EX): no reasonable doubt that the last individual has died


Extinct in the Wild (EW): known only to survive in captivity, cultivation or well outside its natural range



## **Akash Missile System?**


- Akash is India's first indigenously produced medium range SAM that can engage multiple targets from multiple directions and it can be launched from mobile platforms like battle tanks or wheeled trucks
- It has nearly 90% kill probability.
- The development of the Akash SAM was started by the DRDO in the late 1980s as part of the Integrated Guided Missile Development Programme.

## National Geoscience Data Repository (NGDR) Portal Launch

- The Ministry of Mines is set to unveil the National Geoscience Data Repository (NGDR) Portal on December 19, 2023, in a grand ceremony in New Delhi

• On December 15, 2023, the Government of India and the Asian Development Bank (ADB) joined hands, signing a significant agreement for a 37 billion Japanese Yen (\$250 million) loan

#### India and ADB Sign \$250 Million Agreement for Delhi-Meerut RRTS Corridor

- This funding will continue to support the construction of the 82-kilometer Delhi-Meerut Regional Rapid Transit System (RRTS) corridor
- The loan, amounting to 37 billion Japanese Yen, is part of a broader \$1,049 million Multi-tranche Financing Facility (MFF) approved by ADB in 2020 for the RRTS project

# What is ADB?

- ✓ ADB, established in 1966 is owned by 68 members-49 from the region.
- ✓ It is committed to achieving a prosperous, inclusive, resilient, and sustainable Asia and the Pacific while sustaining its efforts to eradicate extreme poverty.
- Further, it assists members and partners by providing loans, technical assistance, grants, and equity investments to promote social and economic development.

#### **Kakrapar Atomic Power Project Unit 4 Attains Criticality**



#### **Kakrapar Atomic Power Project Unit 4 Attains Criticality**

• The rate of fission and power of a controlled chain reaction is constant, and can be controlled with the use of moderators and control rods

• As a result, controlled chain reactions are used in nuclear power plants (nuclear generators).



## Gelephu Special Administrative Region

- Bhutan's King Jigme Khesar Namgyel Wangchuck recently announced the Gelephu Smartcity Project, a mega "international city" near the Indian border
- This project, officially named the Gelephu Special Administrative Region (SAR), spans 1,000 square kilometers and aims to be an economic corridor connecting South Asia with Southeast Asia via India's northeastern states



#### Parliamentary Committee Raises Concerns Over Lumpy Skin Disease Data

- The Parliamentary Standing Committee on Agriculture, Animal Husbandry, and Food Processing has expressed doubts regarding the accuracy of data on cattle deaths due to Lumpy Skin Disease (LSD)
- The committee noted a gap or mismatch between the figures provided by the Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying (DAHD) and the ground reality

#### Lumpy Skin Disease

- Lumpy skin disease virus (LSDV) belongs to the family Poxviridae, subfamily Chordopoxviridae, and genus *Capripoxvirus*
- LSD is a disease of cattle characterised by fever, nodules on the skin, mucous membranes and internal organs, emaciation, enlarged lymph nodes, oedema of the skin, and sometimes death
- The disease is of economic importance as it can cause a temporary reduction in milk production, temporary or permanent sterility in bulls, damage to hides and, occasionally, death

#### WHO Recognizes Noma as Neglected Tropical Disease

 On December 15, 2023, the World Health Organization (WHO) officially included noma, a severe gangrenous disease of the mouth and face, in its list of neglected tropical diseases (NTDs)

 Also known as cancrum oris, noma has a high mortality rate of approximately 90%, and it is associated with extreme poverty, malnutrition, and poor sanitation

## What is gangrene?

- Gangrene is a dangerous and potentially fatal condition that happens when the blood flow to a large area of tissue is cut off
- This causes the tissue to break down and die. Gangrene often turns the affected skin a greenish-black color.

### What is Noma (Cancrum oris)?

- Noma, also known as cancrum oris or gangrenous stomatitis, is a severe and aggressive gangrenous process (a condition wherein body tissues die due to infection or lack of blood supply) that affects the mouth, nose, and lips
- This fatal disease is particularly prevalent among children in sub-Saharan Africa, with an estimated frequency of 1 to 7 cases per 1,000 individuals
- Noma usually begins as an ulcer on the mucus membrane at the alveolar margin of the mouth and rapidly spreads into other parts of the mouth, including teeth, jawbone, cheek, tongue, lips, and nose



#### Century's Largest Flood Hits Far North Queensland

• A massive flood, triggered by the remnants of Tropical Cyclone Jasper, has struck Australia's Far North Queensland (FNQ), marking the largest flood in over a century. Jasper, making landfall on December 13, 2023, left a trail of devastation with unprecedented rainfall

#### Abdel Fattah El-Sisi Wins Third Term as Egypt's President

- Abdel Fattah El-Sisi secures a resounding third term as Egypt's president, winning a staggering 89.6% of the votes in an election where serious challengers were notably absent
- The National Election Authority made the announcement on December 18, marking a continuation of El-Sisi's presidency amid economic challenges and regional tensions

### Colorado Supreme Court Disqualifies Trump from 2024 Ballot

- The Supreme Court in Colorado has ruled that former US President Donald Trump should be removed from the state's presidential election ballot in 2024
- The court cited Trump's alleged involvement in the January 6, 2021 attacks on the US Capitol as grounds for disqualification
- The move comes as Trump supporters protested the election victory of Democratic candidate Joe Biden, claiming electoral fraud

### Inaugural World Odia Language Conference

- The Odisha government has announced plans to organize the firstever 'Biswa Odia Bhasha Sammilani' (World Odia Language Conference) in February 2024
- The Heritage Cabinet, led by Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik, approved the proposal to strengthen and popularize the Odia language
- National and international language experts, along with researchers, will be invited to the three-day event

### Chandrayaan-3 Mission Recognized with Leif Erikson Lunar Prize

- The Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) has been control with the prestigious Leif Erikson Lunar Prize in recognition of its groundbreaking Chandrayaan-3 mission
- The award, presented by the Exploration Museum in Húsavík, Iceland, acknowledges ISRO's exceptional contributions to lunar exploration and understanding celestial phenomena



 $\checkmark$  Under the aegis of Ministry of Home Affairs.

- ✓ It was initially established in 1969 under CISF Act, 1968 to protect major PSUs.
- ✓ However, it was converted to armed force with a larger ambit under an amendment to the Act in 1983.
- ✓ CISF is tasked with providing security to various government installations including country's airports, metros etc.
- $\checkmark$  It also has Fire Wing to response to fire emergencies/accidents.

## First CISF Women DG

- The new director general of the CISF is Nina Singh
- She was promoted to the position of DG, CISF, is an IPS officer from the 1989 batch from the Rajasthan cadre who is currently serving as Special DG.



### Dr. V Mohini Giri Passes Away

- Dr. V Mohini Giri, a prominent women's rights activist, breathed her last recently following a brief illness
- At 86, she left behind a legacy of significant contributions to the empowerment of women in India

## Dr. V Mohini Giri Passes Away

- Dr. Giri served as the Chair of the National Commission for Women (NCW) from 1995 to 1998, leaving an indelible mark on the organization's mission
- Additionally, she chaired the Central Social Welfare Board and led the Guild of Service, a New Delhi-based social service organization advocating for women's and children's rights in education, employment, and financial security

#### Sheikh Mishal al-Ahmad al-Sabah: Kuwait's New Emir

- Kuwait's new emir, Sheikh Mishal al-Ahmad al-Sabah, formally assumed leadership in a swearing-in ceremony before parliament following the passing of his halfbrother, Sheikh Nawaf al-Ahmad al-Sabah
- The ceremony, held during a special session of the National Assembly, marked the beginning of Sheikh Mishal's rule over the Gulf monarchy

#### Jute Corporation of India Launches 'Paat- Mitro' App for Jute Farmers

- The Jute Corporation of India took a significant step toward supporting jute farmers by launching the 'Paat- Mitro' app
- Rachna Shah, Secretary, Ministry of Textiles, inaugurated the app, which aims to provide essential knowledge to farmers for optimal jute cultivation and increased income

#### NASA's 3D-Printed Rotating Detonation Rocket Engine

- NASA's Marshall Space Flight Center in Huntsville, Alabama, has achieved a significant milestone by successfully testing a novel 3D-printed Rotating Detonation Rocket Engine (RDRE)
- The test, lasting 251 seconds and producing more than 5,800 pounds of thrust, emulates typical requirements for a lander touchdown or a deep-space burn that could set a spacecraft on course from the Moon to Mars

#### What is XPoSat Mission?

- Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) is gearing up to commence the New Year with the anticipated launch of its pioneering polarimetry mission, XPoSat, slated for January 1
- This mission marks a significant milestone as the country's third space-based observatory, joining the ranks of the recently launched solar mission, Aditya-L1, and the 2015launched AstroSat

#### Serum Institute's R21/Matrix-M Malaria Vaccine Granted WHO Prequalification

- In a significant milestone in the fight against malaria, the World Health Organization (WHO) granted prequalification to the R21/Matrix-M malaria vaccine developed by the University of Oxford and manufactured by the biotechnology company Serum Institute of India
- The announcement, made on December 21, 2023, signifies that the vaccine meets WHO standards for quality, safety, and efficacy

#### Indian Ocean Naval Symposium (IONS) Conclave of Chiefs (CoC) 2023

- The 8th edition of the IONS Conclave of Chiefs took place in Bangkok, Thailand, from December 19 to 22, 2023
- Chiefs of Navies and senior delegates from 27 member and observer countries participated in this significant event

#### Commissioning of INS Imphal

- On December 26, 2023, INS Imphal (Pennant D68), the third vessel of the Visakhapatnam class stealth-guided missile destroyers, is scheduled to be commissoned into the Indian Navy
- As part of Project 15B, this class represents the latest in indigenous destroyer technology



#### Hu Zhongming : China Appoints New Navy Chief Amid Rising Regional Tensions

- On December 25th, China announced Rear Admiral Hu Zhongming as the new commander of the People's Liberation Army Navy (PLAN), replacing Admiral Dong Jun
- The change in leadership comes at a time of escalating tensions between China and its neighbours over disputed territories in the East and <u>South China Seas</u>

# What is Chronic Wasting Disease (CWD)?


- Chronic wasting disease (CWD) is a fatal neurological illness that affects cervids – a group of animals including deer, elk and moose. It causes behavioral changes, loss of bodily control, drastic weight loss and eventually death
- The disease is caused by malformed proteins called prions that attack brain and nerve tissue
- It spreads through direct contact between animals, or indirectly through prion-contaminated soil, food and surfaces

#### ENEZUELA

- Essequibo is a sparsely populated, forested area constituting over half of Guyana's land
- But Venezuela has claimed it since the 1800s when both were European colonies
- Tensions reignited in 2013 when Guyana permitted ExxonMobil to explore offshore oil and gas reserves near Essequibo, the subsequent discovery of over 17 trillion cubic feet of gas and 11 billion oil-barrel equivalents sparked Venezuela's aspirations

## Disputed Essequibo region

Venezuela will hold a referendum on Sunday on whether to establish a new state in the disputed Essequibo region, an oil-rich territory long ruled by Guyana.

 Aligning with the PM's call to shed vestiges of colonialism, the Indian Navy has unveiled redesigned shoulder insignia for top Admirals incorporating elements




#### **Connection to Shivaji**
